Cloud Architecture and Design (23%)

Cloud Architecture & Design

Service models, deployment patterns, HA/DR, scalability, and storage

Domain Weight

Cloud Architecture and Design accounts for 23% of the CV0-004 exam.

Cloud+ architecture questions ask you to select the right service model, deployment pattern, or storage type for a workload requirement — often comparing cost, control, and operational burden.

Model	Provider Manages	Customer Manages	Examples
IaaS	Physical infra, virtualization	OS, middleware, apps, data	EC2, Azure VMs, Compute Engine
PaaS	Runtime, OS, infra	Applications and data	App Service, Elastic Beanstalk, Cloud Run
SaaS	Entire application stack	Configuration, data, access	Microsoft 365, Salesforce, Workday

Analytics (38%)
Scalability

 Feedback

Ability to handle increased load by adding resources. Vertical (bigger instance) vs horizontal (more instances).

Elasticity

Automatic scale-out/in based on demand. Pay for what you use; scale down during quiet periods.

High Availability & DR Patterns

- Active-active — multiple regions/zones serve traffic simultaneously; highest availability
- Active-passive — standby environment activated on failure; lower cost, higher RTO
- Multi-AZ deployment — replicate across availability zones within a region
- Multi-region — geographic redundancy for disaster recovery
- CDN — cache static content at edge locations; reduce latency and origin load

Storage Type	Use Case	Characteristics
Object	Unstructured data, backups, media	Flat namespace, metadata, highly durable, REST API
Block	Databases, VMs, low-latency apps	Mounted volumes, fixed-size blocks, SAN-like
File	Shared file access, legacy apps	NFS/SMB, shared mount, POSIX semantics

Exam Focus Areas

- Microservices and serverless improve agility but add operational complexity
- Hybrid cloud connects on-premises to public cloud; multi-cloud uses multiple providers
- Match storage type to access pattern — object for blobs, block for databases

Deployment (20%)

Cloud Deployment & Automation

IaC, CI/CD, containers, and deployment strategies

Domain Weight

Deployment accounts for 20% of the CV0-004 exam.

Deployment domain tests automation literacy: IaC tools, pipeline stages, container orchestration, and safe release strategies.

Infrastructure as Code

- Terraform — provider-agnostic, HCL language, state file tracks resources
- CloudFormation — AWS-native, JSON/YAML templates
- ARM/Bicep — Azure-native infrastructure definitions
- IaC benefits: repeatability, version control, peer review, drift detection
- GitOps — Git as single source of truth; changes via pull request merge

Strategy	How It Works	Risk Profile
Blue-Green	Two identical environments; switch traffic instantly	Fast rollback; requires double infra cost
Canary	Route small % of traffic to new version first	Gradual validation; complex routing

Strategy	How It Works	Risk Profile
Rolling	Replace instances incrementally	No full duplicate env; slower rollback

Container Orchestration

- Kubernetes — de facto standard; pods, services, deployments, ingress, HPA
- Managed K8s — EKS, AKS, GKE reduce control plane burden
- ECS/Fargate — AWS container service without managing servers
- Helm charts — package K8s manifests for reusable deployments

CI/CD Pipeline Stages

Source → Build → Test → Staging → Production. Automated tests (unit, integration, security scan) gate promotion. Artifact repositories store versioned builds.

Exam Focus Areas

- IaC enables reproducible environments — manual console clicks do not
- Blue-green enables instant rollback; canary limits blast radius
- Configuration management (Ansible, Chef) complements IaC for in-instance config

Security (18%)

Cloud Security

IAM, encryption, network security, compliance, and secrets

Domain Weight

Security accounts for 18% of the CV0-004 exam.

Cloud security follows shared responsibility: provider secures the cloud; customer secures what they put in the cloud.

Identity & Access Management

- Principle of least privilege — minimal permissions for each role/service account
- RBAC and ABAC — role-based vs attribute-based policy models
- Federation — SSO via SAML/OIDC; no duplicate credentials
- Service accounts / managed identities — apps authenticate without embedded passwords
- MFA for human users — required for console and privileged access

Encryption at Rest

Provider-managed keys (default) vs customer-managed keys (CMK/KMS). Encrypt databases, object storage, volumes.

Encryption in Transit

TLS 1.2+ for all API and user traffic. VPN/private connectivity for hybrid links.

Framework	Focus
HIPAA	Healthcare PHI protection
PCI-DSS	Payment card data security
SOC 2	Service organization controls (security, availability)
GDPR	EU personal data privacy rights

 Feedback

Secrets Management

Never store API keys in code or images. Use vault services (AWS Secrets Manager, Azure Key Vault, HashiCorp Vault) with rotation policies.

Exam Focus Areas

- Security groups / NSGs are stateful firewalls at instance/subnet level
- Compliance is shared — provider offers certified infra; you configure apps correctly
- Incident response in cloud requires cloud-native logging and forensics tools

Operations and Support (17%)

Cloud Operations & Support

Monitoring, optimization, SLAs, cost management, and DR operations

Domain Weight

Operations and Support accounts for 17% of the CV0-004 exam.

Operations questions focus on keeping cloud environments healthy, performant, and cost-effective while meeting SLA commitments.

Monitoring & Observability

- Metrics — CPU, memory, latency, error rates, queue depth (CloudWatch, Azure Monitor)
- Logs — centralized aggregation, structured logging, retention policies
- Traces — distributed tracing for microservices (X-Ray, Jaeger)
- Alerting — thresholds, anomaly detection, on-call escalation
- Dashboards — single pane of glass for ops teams and stakeholders

Cost Optimization

- Right-sizing — match instance size to actual utilization
- Reserved instances / savings plans — commit for discount on steady workloads
- Spot/preemptible instances — cheap compute for fault-tolerant batch jobs
- Auto-scaling — scale down idle resources
- Tagging — attribute costs to teams/projects for chargeback

SLA Management

Understand provider SLA credits vs your customer SLAs. Multi-AZ and health checks improve availability. Document RTO/RPO and test DR runbooks.

Exam Focus Areas

- Performance tuning starts with metrics — measure before optimizing
- Automation reduces toil and human error in operations
- Backup testing is as important as backup creation

Troubleshooting (12%)

Cloud Troubleshooting

Performance, connectivity, RCA, and diagnostic methodologies

Domain Weight

Troubleshooting accounts for 12% of the CV0-004 exam.

 Feedback

Troubleshooting scenarios present symptoms and ask for the logical first diagnostic step or root cause.

Structured Troubleshooting Method

- 1. Identify the problem — scope, impact, timeline
- 2. Gather information — logs, metrics, recent changes
- 3. Form hypothesis — most likely cause based on evidence
- 4. Test hypothesis — isolate variables, reproduce if safe
- 5. Implement fix — change one thing at a time
- 6. Verify resolution — confirm metrics return to baseline
- 7. Document — update runbooks, postmortem if major incident

Symptom	Common Causes	First Checks
High latency	DB bottleneck, no caching, cross-region traffic	APM traces, DB slow query log
Connection refused	Security group, ACL, service down	Port reachability, process status
Intermittent errors	Auto-scaling lag, memory pressure	HPA settings, OOM kills in logs

Change Correlation

Most production issues correlate with a recent deployment or config change. Check CI/CD history and IaC drift first.

Exam Focus Areas

- Start with least invasive diagnostics — ping, logs, metrics
- Root cause analysis asks "why" repeatedly — not just symptom fix
- Log analysis requires centralized logging — checking one server is insufficient at scale

DevOps Fundamentals (10%)

DevOps Fundamentals

Collaboration, CI/CD culture, DORA metrics, and continuous improvement

Domain Weight

DevOps Fundamentals accounts for 10% of the CV0-004 exam.

DevOps Fundamentals tests cultural and process knowledge alongside technical automation concepts.

Core DevOps Principles

- Collaboration — dev and ops share ownership ("you build it, you run it")
- Automation — CI/CD, IaC, testing reduce manual toil
- Continuous improvement — blameless postmortems, retrospectives
- Small batch changes — frequent deploys reduce risk per change
- Feedback loops — monitoring informs development priorities

DORA Metric	What It Measures	Elite Benchmark
Deployment Frequency	How often code reaches production	Multiple deploys per day
Lead Time for Changes	Commit to production duration	Less than one hour
Change Failure Rate	% of deploys causing incidents	0-15%

DORA Metric	What It Measures	Elite Benchmark
MTTR	Time to restore after failure	Less than one hour

Blameless Postmortems

Focus on systemic causes, not individual blame. Output: action items to prevent recurrence. Psychological safety enables honest incident reporting.

Exam Focus Areas

- Git branching supports collaboration — feature branches, PR reviews
- DORA metrics measure delivery performance — not just uptime
- DevOps is culture + practices + tools — not just buying a CI server
